GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Animals in Divisions 265 271 must be Registered Purebreds.
- 2. <u>Clipping</u>: For safety reasons, animals cannot be clipped in the aisles. Please contact Carl Falish, Fair Board representative, for alternative options. Failure to comply may result in loss of premiums and/or removal from future fair entry. Anyone who needs assistance with clipping or grooming their animal, should contact the exhibit coordinator prior to registration, hollie.eichhorst@browncountyfair.com.
- 3. All animals must be in place by 12:00 AM on Wednesday and 9:00 AM on Thursday thru Sunday. We strongly discourage taking your animals out after 9:00 AM
- 4. All bulls over 4 months of age must have a Ring in their Nose.
- 5. No one may approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the ring steward or superintendent.
- 6. If you are in need of the veterinarian, you or a decision making family member, must stay with the animal until the vet has completed the examination and made a diagnosis.
- 7. <u>Age Classifications</u>: <u>Preceding Year</u> = January 1^{st} December 31^{st} of the year **prior** to the fair **Exhibit Year** = January 1^{st} December 31^{st} of the Year **of** the fair
 - a. <u>JUNIOR CALF:</u> Born on or after January 1 of the exhibit year. The calf shall be at least 4 months old at the time of the exhibit.
 - b. **SENIOR CALF**: Date of Birth is between September 1 December 31 of the preceding year.
 - c. **SUMMER YEARLING:** Date of Birth is between May 1 August 31 of the preceding year.
 - d. JUNIOR YEARLING: Date of Birth is between January 1 April 30 of the preceding year.
 - e. **SENIOR YEARLING:** Date of Birth is between September 1 December 31 of the *second* year preceding the exhibit year.
 - f. **2 YEAR OLD OR OLDER:** Born before September 1 of the *Second* year preceding the exhibit year and which has calved during the past year.
