# **GENERAL RULES:**

## **Exhibitor:**

- 1. **Exhibitor Requirement**: Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Cat project or doing similar work in another youth organization to exhibit/show.
- 2. <u>Immunizations:</u> A copy of health and rabies certificates should be sent to the fair office at time of entry. Bring original health and rabies certificates with you.
- 3. **Photo Display**: Bring a photo of your cat for display during the fair. Photo and ribbon can be picked up on Sunday at 6 pm.
- 4. **Showing:** Members will be required to bring their own animals to the judging table. Judging will include general appearance and condition, temperament and proper handling, hair coat, paws and body build.

## **Animal:**

- 1. Age:
  - Adult Cat: An adult cat is over 8 months of age.
  - ❖ Kitten: A kitten is under 8 months of age but at least 4 months old by show date
- 2. Breeds:
  - Cats may be purebred, household pets or mixed breeding.
  - Mixed breed and purebred cats will show together unless numbers in class(es) warrant separation.
- 3. Cat Transport: Cats must be brought to the fair in a carrier.
- **4. Claws**: If cat is not declawed, claws must be trimmed on all four feet.
- 5. Feeding: Each member must provide feeding equipment
- 6. Immunizations:
  - All cats must be immunized for Distemper and Pneumonitis yearly and rabies every 2 years. Immunizations must be given at least 2 weeks before the fair.
  - Any cat displayed having any contagious disease or symptoms will not be allowed to show.
- 7. Long/Short Hair: Long hair is a coat more than 1" in length. Short hair is a coat 1" or less in length.
- 8. Neuter/Spay:
  - An "alter" is an adult former male or female.
  - No adult whole males are to be shown.
- 9. **Showing**: A collar and harness or leash is required during judging.
