INDUSTRY LINKS

The Wisconsin Pork Association offers \$25 rebates to pork producers to help offset costs of testing for Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome (PRRS) and Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea Virus (PEDV).

The following requirements and stipulations apply:

- Producer must complete and mail reimbursement form by December 1, 2021.
- Reimbursement form must include documentation showing proof of test completion
 - Proof of test can include a dated copy of a veterinary clinic bill that shows a line item for PRRS/SECED testing or a dated copy of a test report from a veterinary diagnostic lab (test results can be blacked out; proof of testing completion is all that is required for reimbursement).
