To: All Brown County Fair Exhibitors

The Brown County Fair Board would like to take this opportunity to share with you an outline of our emergency plan, and suggest a few things for your consideration to insure your time at the Fair is the best experience possible.

There is a presence of security on the fairgrounds at all times. In the event you need help, contact a security officer, a Brown County Parks employee or a Fair official. Most Fair officials will be wearing maroon shirts.

There are Emergency Medical Technicians on the fairgrounds during the hours the Fair is open to the public. If you come upon a medical emergency, call 911 and notify a security officer or a Fair official. If you need non-emergency medical attention please come to the Fair office located in the Youth Exhibition Building.

In the event of a fire, calmly leave the area immediately. Call 911 and notify a security officer or Fair official.

Severe weather is always possible during the Fair. The Brown County Fair monitors the weather throughout the Fair. If a **severe weather watch** is issued, the Fair will broadcast the watch over the Fair public address system. A severe weather watch means conditions exist for the development of severe weather. If a **severe weather warning** is issued, there will be a continuous broadcast over the Fair public address system. A severe weather warning means that severe weather is imminent. It is possible that the Fair will be closed at this time.

It is imperative that everyone have a plan in the event of severe weather. **The buildings on the fairgrounds are not storm shelters (not suitable for high winds).** The following are things to think about while making your plan.

1. Have a designated meeting place.
2. Decide when to go to your meeting place (i.e. if a watch or warning is issued).
3. During a thunderstorm seek shelter from lightning (get indoors away from trees).
4. Determine at what point you will leave the grounds until the severe weather passes.

The Brown County Fair Board is dedicated to providing a safe and friendly venue for our exhibitors and guests. With your cooperation, our Fair will continue to be a great community event for years to come.
