- Judging:** Items will be Judged on Quality. (I.e. if Item was Cleaned, Polished, has Cracks, etc...)
- Repeat Items:** Items Once Exhibited Cannot Return Another Year to be Exhibited Again.
- Safety:** Every Precaution will be taken to Insure the Safety of Exhibits, but the Brown County Fair Association and its Volunteers will Not be held Responsible for Loss or Injury.
