**GENERAL RULES:**

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Clothing project or doing similar work in another youth organization in order to exhibit/show.
2. Items for exhibit must be clean and pressed.
3. All posters must be 14" x 22".
4. Tied Fleece Blankets & Pillows that are tied are to be entered in "Home Environment", not Clothing.
5. All garments/articles must be sewn by exhibitor unless listed as "purchased".
6. All articles must have hand or machine stitching.
