Camping Information, Policies & Reservations **Fair Camping Coordinator: Carl Falish 920-843-1405**

Exhibitors who want to park their camper or sleeper trailer on the Brown County Fairgrounds property during the Fair must be willing to adhere to the Policies set forth below and must fill out and return the Reservation form together with the fees specified in order to be considered. In person reservations will be held from 8am until Noon on Saturday, June 25, 2022, and will not be accepted prior to that date and time. Reservations may also be mailed however priority is given to in person reservations.

An exhibitor may reserve no more than three (3) campsites and all fees must be paid in full, in order to receive a reservation. Fair Superintendents and Board of Directors may reserve one campsite each and may do so prior to exhibitors. Fairground lighting does stay on 24/7. All campsites are approximately 18'x40'. For emergency and fire safety reasons, campers must be accessible to the fire lane. Campsites are limited to campers, tents, and sleeper trailers.

The cost to camp is \$50.00 which is due in full, non-refundable, will not be split amongst site occupants, and will not be pro-rated for any reason whatsoever including ejection, regardless of mitigation and does NOT include Fair admission. Checks are to be made payable to: Brown County Fair Association, Inc. Adult supervision is mandatory. Daily or weekly Fair admission must be paid in addition to the cost to camp.

The Brown County Fair Association, Inc., its heirs or assigns, is not responsible for theft, loss, or damage to any persons camping, visiting, or property.

Policies

1. Check in begins at 8am the Monday prior to the opening of the Fair and ends no later than Noon on Wednesday.
2. Check out begins no earlier than 6pm Sunday and no later than the Tuesday following the completion of the Fair.
3. Water hookups are not guaranteed.
4. Overnight Permission Forms must be filled out and turned in for exhibitors.
5. Vehicles are not to be parked in the camping areas and are strictly prohibited from entering the camping areas after 3pm on Wednesday and after 9am on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
6. Absolutely NO campfires on the ground or in containers; avoid open flames at all times.
7. Weapons and fireworks are strictly prohibited during the Fair.
8. Pets are not allowed to camp.
9. Campers are responsible for their own trash collection and disposal or recycling on a daily basis. Campers leaving trash/recycling on-site or otherwise blowing around may result in the loss of future Fair camping privileges. Campers are to leave the site in the same condition as when they arrived.
10. Any camper caught leaking black or grey water may forfeit future Fair camping privileges.
11. Quiet Time begins when the Fair closes and continues until 6:30am.
12. Generators must have adequate mufflers, be exhausted away from campers/tents, and adhere to Quiet Time. Medical needs generators under 70dBs are acceptable for overnight use.

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- 13. Power cords must be in good repair, grounded, between 10 and 12 gauge and up to 100' in length depending on site location. Inadequate power cords will be removed and not returned until the Fair ends. NOTE: Electricity is not guaranteed and may not always be available. Priority is always given to the electrical needs throughout the barns.
- 14. Air conditioning is to be operated by generator only.
- 15. Excessive rowdiness, disruptive, or disorderly behavior will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the campgrounds and/or the removal of future Fair camping privileges.

FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THE INFORMATION/POLICIES SET FORTH HEREIN MAY RESULT IN EJECTION FROM THE CAMPSITE AND/OR THE REMOVAL OF FUTURE FAIR CAMPING PRIVILEGES.
