2023 Brown County Fair Kiddie Showmanship Rules and Entry Form

The Brown County Fair Kiddie Showmanship is an opportunity for youth between the ages of 4 and 8 as of January 1 of the current year to begin to gain the knowledge and skills involved in showing animals. Kiddie Showmanship will be held on Saturday, August 19, 2023.

General Rules:

- 1. Two classes will be held: 4-6 year old group and 7-8 year old group. Age is determined as of January 1 of the current year. Large classes may be further split into two classes.
- 2. Children are required to wear a showmanship number that will be distributed prior to the show.
- 3. Children will be judged on the way they handle their animal and basic showmanship show skills. No coaching of exhibitors during the show will be allowed.
- 4. Families with children in both age groups may show the same animal. Families with two or more children in the same age group may not share the same animal.
- 5. Ribbons will be given to all participants.

Dairy/Beef Rules:

- 1. Calves must be born between March 1 and July 1 of the current year. It can be a heifer, steer, or bull. Due to safety concerns, no over-age calves will be allowed.
- 2. Calves should be brought to the fair by 10:30 a.m. on Saturday.

Swine/Sheep/Goats Rules:

1. Swine, Sheep or Goats that are shown as part of the Junior or Open show are allowed to be shown for Kiddie Showmanship.

Poultry/Rabbits Rules:

1. Poultry and Rabbits should be in a cage that can sit in a wagon (like the little red wagons). The exhibitors will be pulling their animals around the show ring.
