GENERAL RULES:

- Animals:**
 - ❖ Exhibitors may use 1 or more animals as an example.
 - ❖ Animals must be confined or restrained by a leash or halter.
 - ❖ Due to health concerns, reptiles cannot be shown.
 - ❖ All animals go home after judging.
- Displays/Posters:** All posters must be 14"x22". Displays should be no larger than 36"x36".
- Entry Requirement:** Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Animal, Veterinary Science, Small Pets or any other animal project or doing similar work in another youth organization in order to exhibit/show.

DIVISION 120 – VETERINARY SCIENCE – THE NORMAL ANIMAL

CLASS NO.

- Poster of ways to maintain animal health
- Poster of the 5 systems present in the body of animals and birds
- Poster showing the main parts of the heart

DIVISION 121 – VETERINARY SCIENCE – ANIMAL DISEASE

CLASS NO.

- Poster of bacterial and viral diseases
- Poster or display of external and internal parasites
- Poster of diseases caused by stress and heredity
- Poster or display of plants or home products which are poisonous to animals

DIVISION 123 – ANIMAL SCIENCE

CLASS NO.

1. First aid kit for animal or human
2. Pet accessory or garment made by member (hat, leash, etc.)
3. Pet bed or carrier made by member
4. Pet climbing pole or a slant board made by member
5. Picture story – a series of 4 photographs illustrating a specific event, activity or topic with captions
6. Poster or chart on the retail cuts of beef, lamb or pork
7. Poster or display on products from an animal or animals
8. Poster or display on proper animal care
9. Poster or display on proper animal housing
10. Poster or display on proper animal nutrition
11. Poster, scrapbook, or display illustrating 4 or more breeds
12. Poster, scrapbook, or display tracing the history and development on different breeds

14. Scrapbook about your project pet
15. Story about your project pet (1 page)
16. Written report (2 pages max) describing the factors to consider before getting a pet. Example: owner's lifestyle, breed characteristics, etc.
17. Poster, labeling the external anatomy of a dog.
18. A written report, minimum one page and not to exceed 2 pages, describing a career in veterinary medicine.
19. Any other exhibit
