**GENERAL RULES:**

1. Animals in Divisions 265 - 271 must be Registered Purebreds.
2. **Clipping:** For safety reasons, animals cannot be clipped in the aisles. Please contact Carl Falish, Fair Board representative, for alternative options. Failure to comply may result in loss of premiums and/or removal from future fair entry. Anyone who needs assistance with clipping or grooming their animal, should contact the exhibit coordinator prior to registration, [hollie.eichhorst@browncountyfair.com](mailto:hollie.eichhorst@browncountyfair.com).
3. **All animals must be in place by 12:00 AM on Wednesday and cleaned up and in place by 9:00 AM on Thursday thru Sunday. We strongly discourage taking your animals out after 9:00 AM**
4. All bulls over 4 months of age must have a Ring in their Nose.
5. No one may approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the ring steward or superintendent.
6. If you are in need of the veterinarian, you or a decision making family member, must stay with the animal until the vet has completed the examination and made a diagnosis.

8. **Age Classifications:** **Preceding Year** = January 1<sup>st</sup> – December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year **prior** to the fair  
**Exhibit Year** = January 1<sup>st</sup> – December 31<sup>st</sup> of the Year **of** the fair
  - a. **JUNIOR CALF:** Born on or after January 1 of the exhibit year. The calf shall be at least 4 months old at the time of the exhibit.
  - b. **SENIOR CALF:** Date of Birth is between September 1 - December 31 of the preceding year.
  - c. **SUMMER YEARLING:** Date of Birth is between May 1 - August 31 of the preceding year.
  - d. **JUNIOR YEARLING:** Date of Birth is between January 1 - April 30 of the preceding year.
  - e. **SENIOR YEARLING:** Date of Birth is between September 1 - December 31 of the *second* year preceding the exhibit year.
  - f. **2 YEAR OLD OR OLDER:** Born before September 1 of the *Second* year preceding the exhibit year and which has calved during the past year.
