GENERAL RULES:

Exhibitor:

- 1. Entry Requirements:
 - a. Exhibitors showing Purebred Animals 1 year or over will be required to show Certificate of Registry to Superintendent; Certificate must show that animal is registered in the name of the Exhibitor
 - b. All Registration Transfers must be made at least 20 days prior to the Fair.

2. **Day of Show Questions**: Exhibitors are not allowed to approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the ring steward or superintendent.

All animals must be in place by 12:00 AM on Wednesday and cleaned up and in place by 9:00 AM on Thursday thru Sunday. We strongly discourage taking your animals out after 9:00 AM

If you are in need of the veterinarian, you or a decision- making family member, must stay with the animal until the vet has completed the examination and made diagnosis.

Animals:

- 1. **<u>Ownership</u>**: Only Animals registered in Owner's Name may be shown.
- 2. <u>Purebred</u>: Animals in all divisions must be registered purebreds.
- 3. Shearing:
 - a. Registered Columbias, Corriedales, Rambouillets & Targhees shall be shown with 2 inches or less of wool.
 - b. All other breeds shall have been completely shorn not more than 2 months or less than 2 weeks prior to Show Date.

Shearing: For safety reasons, animals cannot be sheared in the aisles. Please contact Carl Falish, Fair Board representative, for alternative options. Failure to comply may result in loss of premiums and/or removal from future fair entry. Anyone who needs assistance with clipping or grooming their animal should contact the exhibit coordinator prior to registration, hollie.eichhorst@browncountyfair.com.

- 4. <u>**Trough**</u>: Exhibitors must furnish their own trough.
- 5. <u>Age Classifications</u>:

c.

- a. **Spring Lamb:** A spring lamb is one born on or after February 16 of the exhibit year.
- b. <u>Winter Lamb</u>: A winter lamb is one born between January 1 and February 15 of the exhibit year.
- c. **Fall Lamb:** A fall lamb is one born between August 31 and December 31 of the preceding exhibit year.
- <u>Yearling</u>: A yearling ram or ewe is one born outside the date of birth limitation in paragraphs (a-c). The age of yearling may be subject to verification by a veterinarian's examination whose findings shall be final.
- e. Market Lamb: A market lamb is one born on or after January 1 of the exhibit year.

DIVISION 300 - MARKET LAMBS

RULES:

- 1. <u>Divisions</u>: After final weigh-in of the Market Lambs, Sheep Superintendent(s) will equally divide divisions based on weight.
- 2. <u>Animal Limit</u>: No more than 3 market animals may be shown per exhibitor.
- 3. <u>Multiple Entries</u>: If an exhibitor shows more than one animal & the market animals fall into the same class number, the other animal(s) must be shown by another eligible exhibitor. ONLY 1 premium will be awarded per exhibitor, per class number.

4. <u>Splitting Divisions</u>: large divisions will be split at the discretion of the judge and the department superintendent.
